



SILENT SENTINEL-- The dark sky of night gives the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission's new Andrew's Elevated Water Storage Tank, near Camp Springs, a flying saucer-like appearance. The structure holds three million gallons of filtered water in reserve to meet peak customer and fire protection requirements in the Camp Springs area. It is one of 40 water storage tanks operated by the WSSC in the bi-county Suburban Maryland Area.
