"TO ALL OUR HAWK EYES"

BACKGROUND OF OUR BOWLING GROUPS



The organized Bowling Groups of boys and girls 7 through 18, under the Camp Springs Youth Club, came into being in September 1959. We had ten teams of the older boys and girls and four to six teams of our Little Ducks. (These shifted, as the young folks attended, especially at the end of the season). We bowled each Saturday morning at the Ft. Davis Bowling Alley in Fairfax Village. Our trophy night (for both groups) was held at Bells Methodist Church on Friday, March 25th. This was well attended and, we believe every child thoroughly enjoyed the evening.

This year, our group grew from about 115 (last year's group) to approximately 250. This, of course, presented a new challenge. Our group was again split; forming the "Little Ducks" with our 7 thru 10 yr. olds; and the "Hawk Eyes" with our 11 thru 18 year olds. Mr. Carl Staton, who together with Mr. Buddy Simmons and the help of others, looked after the Little Ducks last year, came forward with that same enthusiasm and accepted complete responsibility for our Little Ducks again this year. Mrs. McGovern has faithfully worked along with him this year, as well as many other parents. We congratulate all these folks on a job well done.

Well, this left about 150 Hawk Eyes to be made into teams and put into action. Our first Saturday was spent with placing 12 bowlers on each 2 lanes and letting them bowl for an average. During the week, the entire Kidwell family (Mr. & Mrs., Ray and Fran) helped by figuring the averages and helping place boys & girls on Teams by averages to make them as fairly balanced as possible. Also, Team names had to be chosen, cards made up, and book work begun! Our group organized into 24 teams with 6 members each. On the following Saturday, they were called by name, placed on an Alley, given the name of their team, and chose Team Captains. Immediately following, there was a meeting of the Team Captains to begin to organize the League. Captains were instructed as to filling out the Score sheets, etc., etc., and suggestions were made as to by-laws, etc. Several committees were appointed to carry out phases of the work. Bylaws were written, (in conjunction with the American Junior Bowling Congress rules), rules for absenteeism were made, and copies of these were printed and given to each bowler - even to rules for foul lines, etc. Also, the Captains chose Co-Captains to take over when the Capt. was absent, and also, to help each week. Several meetings took place: one was a Cook-Out where the officers were elected - Pres.- Ray Kidwell, Vice-Pres.-Woody and Sec.-Treas- Chris Bost. Another meeting was held in Bells Church Social Hall followed by a Dance and refreshments. Also, the Hawk Eyes (entire group) held a dance in February. This was really a ball! All the planning, decorating, etc., was done by special committees of the Hawk Eyes. Several other meetings were held with special groups all during the season. The final program -AWARDS NIGHT -was also planned and carried out by a special committee.

This has been an excellent example of good fellowship, fine behavior and keen bowling. We've had a grand time together and certainly given a good name to the Camp Springs Youth Club.
