Daniel Cecchini, Athlete, Son of Boxing Referee

Daniel T. Cecchini, 20, son of an area boxing referee, died today of lymphoma at Alexandria Hospital. He lived at 4407 Lakeview Drive, Temple Hills, Md.

A District native, he attended Linton Hall Military School in Prince William County, Va., and St. John's High School. He also attended Crossland High School in Camp Springs, where he played football his sophomore year and where he won awards as a track athlete.

He won a partial scholarship in track to Columbia (Tenn.) Military Academy, where he was selected the school's outstanding athlete for 1967.

Mr. Cecchini then received a four-year track scholarship to Mississippi State University, which he had been attending until he became ill in May.

His father, H. A. (Yaddy) Cecchini is a boxing referee here.

Besides his parents he leaves a brother, Stephen.
