## ABOUT MGY.SGT.CHARLES ERWIN

Mgy.Sgt.Erwin enlisted in the U.S.Marine Band in June of 1948. He had just completed his high school education at Hobart, Indiana and at the time of his enlistment was the youngest man in the band.

Since that month, almost sixteen years ago, Sgt.Erwin has played in 48 of our 50 states in concerts and also holds the honor of appearing as solcist in each of these states.

As a general rule when each young musician enters the Marine Band he must, by virtue of his lack of experience, start from the bottom of the section. Sgt.Erwin was no exception to this rule. Through nearly 10 years of concetrated effort he advanced to the head of the cornet section and became the solo cornetist of the Marine Band.

Playing in the Marine Band is an honor that few musicians can claim. Known as "The President's Own", th band has played before Kings, Queens, and various heads of state and has played for every President of the United States since John Adams.
