Five Records Set in Meet At Wakefield

Led by two relay teams, Wakefield High School won its own invitational track meet last night for the first time in five years.

The Warriors padded a narrow lead by taking the 380-yard relay with three events remaining and stood off bids by Northwood and defending champion Hammond.

Wakefield finished with 57 points, to 51 for Hammond and 48 for Northwood. Twenty-nine high schools competed in the meet, which was held in a steady rain.

Bill Sullivan, Tom Daniel, Steve Gaskins and Mike Bell won the 399 relay for Wakefield after the shuttle hurdle unit had won to move the Warriors within range.

Gaskins and Daniel also ran on the shuttle hurdle team, and each contributed an individual victory, Gaskins in the pole vault and Daniel in the high hurdles.

Previous Warrior victories in the nine-year-old meet came in 1958 and 1960. Hammond was halted in its attempt for a third straight title.



Bob Yandell of Hammond, winner of the discus in yesterday's Wakefield Invitational track meet, set a meet record of 164 feet 8 inches.

Hammond's Bob Yandell tossed the discus 164 feet 7½ inches and was one of five record-breakers in the meet. Yandell, who has been defeated only once in the last two seasons, has set four meet records this spring.
