

ton from Shaw University to participate in a baseball tryout camp conducted by the old Senators in conjunction with the *Washington Daily News* . . . the old Senators didn't sign him, but the Orioles did, paving the way for Chuck ultimately to land with the new Senators.

The speedy outfielder, who also has seen service as a catcher, first baseman, second baseman and shortstop, batted safely in 17 straight games last season while leading the Senators in batting average (.310), games (151), at bats (542), runs (73), hits (168), total bases (256), runs batted in (75), doubles (25), triples (tied with Chuck Cottier, 6), home runs (tied with Harry Bright, 17), stolen bases (28), and sacrifice flies (6).

Chuck Hinton

One of baseball's rising stars, Hinton was batting .156 after the first month of the 1962 season, but finished with a .310 average, fourth best in the American League . . . Acquired from the Baltimore organization for \$75,000 when the American League expanded to 10 clubs, Hinton led the Northern League with a .358 mark with Aberdeen in 1959 and paced the California League at .369 with Stockton in 1960.

Chuck, who also is a sportscaster for Station WUST and a Washington resident with a thriving insurance business, hitch-hiked to Washington

HOW TO KEEP SCORE

Half the fun at a ball game is keeping your own score. It adds to the enjoyment of watching a ball game, and talking about it days, weeks and even months later. And the best part of it is that it's easy.

Most scorers number the nine positions, and use symbols and abbreviations. The standard numbering plan is: pitcher, 1; catcher, 2; first baseman, 3; second baseman, 4; third baseman, 5; shortstop, 6; left fielder, 7; center fielder, 8; and right fielder, 9.

Suggested abbreviations: W for walk; K for strikeout; E for error; WP for wild pitch; PB for passed ball; S for sacrifice; SF for sacrifice fly; F for foul out.

Recording of the play is simple if the batter is retired. If he flies to left, a 7 tells the story (F-7 in case it's a foul fly). If he is thrown out, say third to first, it's 5-3, the first figure indicating the man fielding and throwing the ball and the second figure showing the man making the putout.

When a batter hits safely, use a single bar (—) for a single; a double bar (=) for a double; three bars (==) for a triple and four (==) for a home run. Direction of the hit can be indicated by a number (—7, single to left; =8, double to center, etc.)


When a batter reaches first base, how he did it is recorded in the lower right hand corner of the square. The batter's progress around the bases is then recorded in the four corners of his box. The lower right corner represents first base, upper right, second base, upper left, third, and lower left is home plate.

Hamlin to second. (Note the 5, Phillips position number, at second base for Hamlin showing how he advanced.) Hinton grounded out, third to first (5-3), both men, Hamlin and Phillips, advanced one base. (Note the 8 for Hamlin and Phillips showing how they advanced.) Lock hit a sacrifice fly to leftfield (SF-7) scoring Hamlin. (It is convenient to circle all runs as shown so that scoring plays may be seen at a glance.) Phillips remained at second. Brown then hit a home run into the centerfield stands (==8) and scored along with Phillips. Piersall grounded out to the first baseman, unassisted (3U).

You'll find that you'll enjoy the game all the more when you start keeping an accurate scorecard, and before long you'll have a bag full of your own special scoring gimmicks, symbols and abbreviations.
